



2021 ROCK-A-THON RULES and REGULATIONS

Q. Why is the Rock-A-Thon a required event?

To meet our budget for music, drill, Tecs, Travel, etc, our fundraising has to be met in our budget. As a Band Booster, we want to provide a way for students to raise money for their band accounts while also replenishing the general fund. This is one way for us to have a small requirement while still allowing each band member to raise as much or as little as he/she needs. **Each student is required to participate and raise the minimum \$40.**

Q. Why is the purpose of the Rock-a-Thon?

Our award-winning band has a lot of excitement planned this year. This is a **required event**, but it is important for our students to have enjoy this event with their band friends. Our band will be traveling to many football games, competitions, and participating in memorable events. Students also have other expenses like meal plans, shoes, and gloves. We want to give our students an opportunity to raise money to help support them financially this year, so that he/she will be able to participate without financial worry. This will be the easiest opportunity for your student to earn his/her funds for these events.

Q. What will the students be doing at the Rock-A-Thon?

The students will be rocking in a rocking chair. Students will be hanging out with friends, playing games, talking, etc. while rocking in their chair. Yes, they are allowed to go to the bathroom at their discretion. Yes, they can get out of their rocking chair to participate in activities happening in the middle of the cafeteria like Trivia, line dancing, corn hole tournament, minute to win it games, etc.

Q. What am I allowed to bring?

Please use your best judgement. **Bring your ROCKING CHAIR.** You are also encouraged to bring snacks, pillows, blankets, devices with earbuds, games, a small table, decoration for your chair, and slippers. You can bring anything that will make your space exciting to hang out in for the day. You may consider bringing an extension cord and power strip. Please understand that all items you bring are your responsibility, and the North Paulding Band will not be responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged property.

Q. What kind of Rocking Chair can I bring?

If you can get it in the cafeteria, then you can bring it. You are responsible for getting it there. Porch rocking chairs, Laz-y-boys, sports rocking chairs, gliders, etc.

Q. What are the requirements to participate?

To participate, you must raise at least \$40. Students will keep 100% of everything they collect over \$40 in their band account. For example, if you raise \$200, then your band account will reflect \$160 for you to use toward shoes, gloves, meal plan, or band payments.

Q. How long is the Rock-A-Thon?

We will start the actual rocking at 5:00 pm on **Saturday, August 14th**, and we will finish at 12:00am. The actual rocking will stop at 11:00pm to allow time for all the students to start cleaning up. Parents are welcome to come in at 11:00pm to help take things to the car.

Q. How is this going to be fun?

A. This event is structured for the students to make a memorable experience raising money for the band. Students are working hard at the beginning of the year to provide a successful band experience. During the Rock-a-Thon, we will have a Corn Hole Tournament, DJ, Trivia, Minute to Win It, and Prizes. The idea is to have fun raising funds for the band and helping students to make band affordable while building a camaraderie amongst the band students.
